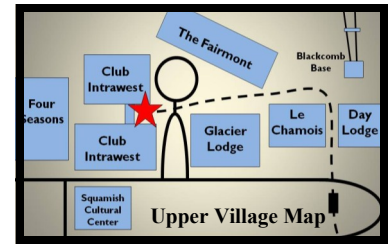

In-Room Recipe Idea

Peanut Butter Microwave Fudge:

- 2/3 cup butter
- 2/3 cup peanut butter
- 6 cups powdered sugar
- 1/3 cup milk
- 1 Tbsp vanilla

Microwave butter and peanut butter 1.5—2 min until butter melts. Stir well. Add rest of ingredients, stir well. Microwave 1 min. Stir well. Pour into greased 9 inch square baking pan and refrigerate for 1 hour. Cut & enjoy!
